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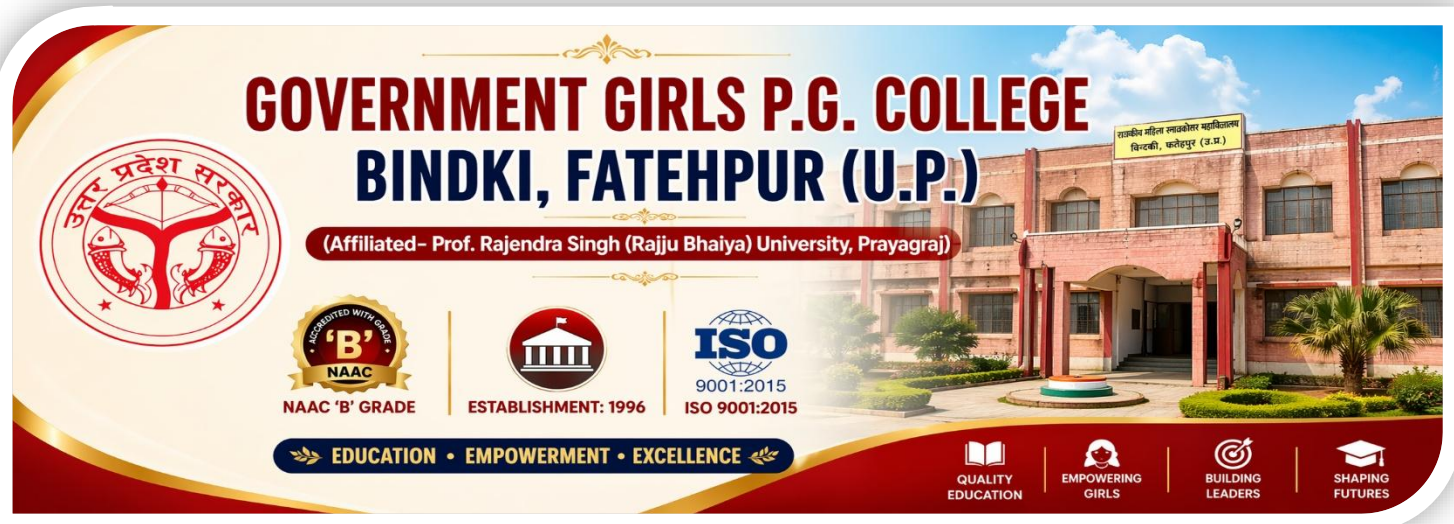
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INTRODUCTION

Bindki is about 25 kms from Fatehpur and 51 kms from Kanpur and well connected through rail and road networks. The nearby airport is Kanpur domestic terminal situated only 45 kilometers from Bindki.

5. Word limit – 2500-10000, Abstract - 150 to 200 words, 8. Key words - minimum 6
6. Graphs should be included in pic format only.

7. Order of writing Reference- Author's surname, author's first name, book name, publisher's name and place, publication year, page number (for example- Gaur, Ramakant, Nari Sangharsh Ka Samkaleen Paksha, Anshika Prakashan, Prayagraj, 2010, page number - 114).
8. Write the author's name, designation and name of the institution below the research title.
9. At the end of the research paper or article, the author must write his/her mobile number and email ID so that you can be contacted as per requirement.
