### **\*All participants must pay attention to the following guidelines while preparing your research paper:**

1. Language: Hindi or English
2. Font: Kurti Dev 10 for Hindi and New Times Roman for English
3. Font size – (New Times Roman) 12 and (Kruti Dev-10 ) 16
4. File - Word file
5. PDF files will not be accepted under any circumstances.
6. Research papers will not be accepted on WhatsApp. only email.
7. Word limit – 2500-5000
8. Spacing - Top 1 CM, Bottom 1 CM, Left 1 CM, Right 1 CM,
9. Research summary - 150 to 200 words
10. Key words - minimum 6
11. It is necessary to have a conclusion at the end of the research.
12. Reference - at the end (footnotes will not be accepted.)
13. Graphs should be included in pic format only
14. Order of writing Reference- Author's surname, author's first name, book name, publisher's name and place, publication year, page number (for example- Gaur, Ramakant, Nari Sangharsh Ka Samkaleen Paksha, Anshika Prakashan, Prayagraj, 2010, page number - 114).
15. How to quote: all quotations should be written within double inverted commas "..... ."
16. Write the reference number after the referenced part is over. (eg - "....."1 or whatever.)
17. Bold the title and sub title of the research article.
18. Do not use references in research summary and conclusion.
19. Write the author's name, designation and name of the institution below the research title.
20. At the end of the research article, the author must write his mobile number and email ID. So that you can be contacted as per requirement.
